– READ TOGETHER IN DAYCARE

DEAR PARENTS,

It is lovely to read together. At the same time, it strengthens your child's language skills and basis to learn to read. With this bag, we want to give you the inspiration for how you can read with your child.

The bag contains five different books for reading aloud:

- Mit stamtræ (My family tree)
- Oskar og den skrupsultne drage (Oscar and the ravenous dragon)
- Store dyr, Løve (Large animals, Lion)
- Small facts: Træer (Trees)
- Opfindelser, strikkede huer og en dum kat (Inventions, knitted hats and a stupid cat)

The folder contains:

- A pamphlet, in which you can read about why it is important to read with your child and how you can support your child's linguistic development
- The instructions "How to read with your child" with specific tips on how to read together with your child
- The sheet "Ideas for details questions", which provides specific examples of question for the book "Opfindelser, strikkede huer og en dum kat" (Inventions, knitted hats and a stupid cat)
- The drawing sheets "My family" and "My invention"
- Instructions for using the READ app where you can register every time you have read together. The log in to the app will be provided together with the bag.

After you are finished, the bag and books must be returned. You may keep the materials in the folder. Perhaps hang the instructions up on the fridge.
