– READ TOGETHER IN GRADE 1

DEAR PARENTS,

With this bag, we want to give you the inspiration for how you can read with your child and consequently support the development of your child's reading skills. Your child will become better at reading by reading a lot and by reading aloud for you.

The bag contains six different books:

- Rumleskaft (Rumplestiltskin)
- Viola i tårnet (Viola in the tower)
- Small facts: Sol, måne og stjerner (Sun, moon and stars)
- Kanin (Rabbit)
- Anton, Rosa og ræven (Anton, Rosa and the fox)
- Lillebror (højtlesningsbog) (Little brother) (reading aloud book)

The folder contains:

- A pamphlet in which you can read about the importance of reading with your child
- The instructions "How to read with your child" with specific tips on how to read together with your child
- "My book"
- Bookmark
- The sheet: "How you can support your child's independent reading" where you get specific suggestions on how you can support your child's reading of words and to strengthen the desire to read

The books in the bag are of various levels of difficulty. If your child cannot read one of the books on his or her own yet, you can read it aloud.

After you are finished, the bag and books must be returned. You may keep the materials in the folder. Perhaps hang the instructions up on the fridge.
